

Concens® INFORMATION ABOUT EU Directive 2011/65/EU and Directive 2015/863 (RoHS)

To Concens customers

EU Directive 2011/65/EU restricts the use of 6 substances: Lead, Mercury, Hexavalent chromium, Polybrominated biphenyls, and Polybrominated diphenyl ether are all restricted to a maximum concentration of 1000 ppm. Cadmium is restricted to a maximum concentration level of 100 ppm.

Concens confirms that our products are in compliance with the EU RoHS directive 2011/65/EU. Some Concens products might contain one of the restricted substances above the threshold, but these instances are covered by valid exemptions listed in Annex III.

On 31 March 2015, Directive 2011/65/EU was amended by Directive 2015/863. Directive 2015/863 further restricts the use of four phthalates: DEHP, BBP, DBP, and DIBP to a maximum concentration of 1000 ppm. The amendment has been in force from 22 July 2019 for electronic devices, except for medical equipment. Medical equipment is in scope from 22 July 2021. Concens products will not contain any of the restricted substances above the threshold as per the aforementioned deadlines.

Concens will monitor changes in the RoHS directive closely and update our products and documentation accordingly.
